Camps, intensive workshops, and continuing classes will keep dancers moving and growing in new and challenging ways throughout the summer months.

Participating in our summer program provides many opportunities for dancers. They develop, maintain and perfect technique while enjoying the benefits of cardiovascular exercise. Additionally dancers may qualify for advancement in class placement for the regular dance season.

The Summer Program is all about experience. Take classes with guest artists and resident City Ballet faculty. Try a new dance style! This is your time to shine and become the best dancer you can possibly be in a motivating, encouraging, and productive environment.

Sounds Great! How does the summer program work?

Camps and intensives are held as one-week sessions. These will usually conclude with an informal performance or presentation. Instructors will cover all additional information at the beginning of each session. If the dancer is participating in camps for several consecutive hours, he/she is strongly encouraged to bring a healthy snack or lunch, as well as bottled water, to enjoy during designated breaks.

Continuing classes are offered at various levels, for all disciplines. Dance cards will be available again to allow flexibility in taking continuing classes. Since it is summer, there are slightly fewer class levels. For appropriate class placement, please refer to the class description or consult with the instructor.

Dance cards will be used for continuing summer classes. Each card is \$85 for 5 dance hours. Please note the cards are non-refundable and expire at the end of the summer session. 5% discount if multiple cards purchased in single transaction.

City Ballet Policies

DEPOSIT: A non-refundable deposit of half the camp fee is required at registration. The remaining balance is due June 1st.

Registrations received and paid in full by May 1st will receive a 5% discount.

Any class not meeting minimum enrollment may be cancelled or combined. In the event of cancellation by City Ballet, all deposits will be refunded. We will give at least one week notice of cancellation.

Dancers must be the appropriate age by the start of the class.

No student will be allowed to leave the City Ballet studio without written parental consent.

Dancers should dress in proper dance attire. Hair is preferred to be pulled securely away from the face. No special dance attire purchases are required to participate in Summer Dance 2011.

Healthy snacks, lunches, and a water bottle should be packed for those staying at the studio for an extended period of time. Food is to be consumed only in designated areas.
